Casual position

This is a casual position with 1-2 shifts per week available. Approximate shift times are:

- Tuesday 7 am - 4.30 pm
- Wednesday 7 am - 4.30 pm

The shifts are determined by the quantity of eggs to grade each week.

The feather&PECK story is part of the reason consumers and chefs love our eggs.

Our eggs are grown in South Australia on 8 family farms and then distributed to the food service sector (cafes and restaurants) and to resellers (supermarkets, providores, fruit and vegetable retailers and butchers.)

About the job

Grading eggs is a TEAM effort. Once the egg grading machine starts at 7 am, we require each team member to focus on their station, help other team members when needed and handle each egg carefully.

This role requires a level of physical fitness to be able to:

- stand for the whole shift
- work quickly, because the pace is determined by the grading machine
- handle eggs carefully and with dexterity
- lift and shift boxes of eggs that weigh approximately 10.5 kgs
- examine eggs under ultraviolet light to find cracks
- clean parts of the egg grader at the end of the shift

We provide noise-reduction headphones with bluetooth capability so you can listen to music or podcasts while working.

We have 15-minute tea breaks (included in your hours) and a half hour lunch break.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Be punctual and ready to start grading at 7 am
- Work the full variety of stations on the egg grader including:
 - Loading the eggs on to the grader
 - Sorting 'seconds' eggs - we call them googlies
 - Candling to examine for cracks / defects under ultra-violet light
 - Pack eggs into dozens and load into shippers (boxes) for delivery
 - Assemble shippers
 - Load pallets
 - Hand sort oversize and undersize eggs
- Handle eggs carefully and efficiently
- Respond to the direction and coaching of the leading hand or general manager
- Be committed to working as a team

Required Experience/Skills

- Willingness to learn on the job and improve skills
- Physical ability to stand, lift and handle eggs
- Problem solving skills
- Teamwork
- Good numeracy skills

- Production line experience
- Food manufacturing experience
- Digital literacy
- Ability to work cheerfully and interact well with team members
